


**Polisi Gwisg Ysgol
School Uniform Policy**

Ffederasiwn Ysgol Dyffryn Dulas ac Ysgol Pennal



1. Cyflwyniad

Polisi'r ysgol yw fod pob plentyn yn gwisgo gwisg ysgol pan yn mynchu'r ysgol neu pan yn mynchu digwyddiadau ble mae'r plentyn yn cynrychioli'r ysgol y tu allan i oriau arferol yr ysgol.

Seilir y polisi hwn ar y gred fod gwisg ysgol yn:

- hybu ymdeimlad o falchder o'n hysgol;
- creu ymdeimlad o fod yn rhan o gymuned sydd yn perthyn i'r ysgol;
- ymarferol, taclus a thwt;
- gwneud i bod plentyn deimlo'n gyfartal o ran ymddangosiad;
- cael i'w ystyried fel dillad addas ar gyfer ysgol ac yn werth da am arian;

Mae'r polisi gwisg ysgol yn rhan greiddiol o ymroddiad yr ysgol tuag at cydraddoldeb a chynhwysiad. Mae Corff Llywodraethol yr ysgol yn credu fod gwisg ysgol yn galluogi i holl ddisgyblion yr ysgol rannu ymdeimlad o hunaniaeth gan ddathlu nodweddion sydd yn gyffredin i bawb, gan hefyd barchu amrywiaeth. Rydym yn dymuno gweld y dysgwyr â logo'r ysgol ar eu *siwmpers* ond nid yw hyn yn orfodol.

Bydd yr ysgol hefyd yn sicrhau cyfleon i rieni brynu dillad ysgol ail-law (sydd â logo'r ysgol arnynt) yn barhaus ac mewn Nosweithiau rhieni / Digwyddiadau e.e. Ffair Nadolig, Rasio'r Tren, Barbeciw

Os ydych yn ansicr, yna dylech gysylltu a Swyddfa'r ysgol cyn prynu gwisg.

2. Y Wisg Ysgol

Rydym yn annog rhieni neu ofalwyr i brynu gwisg ysgol hyd oed pan fydd plentyn yn yr oed meithrin. Mae'r wisg fel a ganlyn;

- trowsus / sgert ddu / llwyd
- esgidiau addas du
- crys polo gwyn
- crys chwys marwn/gwyrrd

Yn ystod tymor yr haf gall disgyblion wisgo ffrog haf neu drowsus byr pe dymunir.

3. Enwau ar ddillad / dillad coll

Rydym yn annog y rhieni, gofalwyr a phlant i sicrhau fod pob dilledyn wedi ei labelu yn glir gyda enw'r plentyn. Mae hyn yn cynnwys esgidiau a plimsolls addysg gorfforol. Bydd pob dilledyn sydd ddim yn cael ei hawlio ar ddiwedd pob hanner tymor yn mynd i fanc dillad cyfagos neu yn cael ei ail-gylchu o fewn yr ysgol.

4. Esgidiau

Rydym yn annog y plant i wisgo esgidiau du i'r ysgol. Credwn fod hyn yn gwneud i'r disgyblion edrych yn daclus ar gyfer mynchu'r ysgol. Dylai fod yr esgidiau yn ddiogel ac yn addas ichwarae yn ddiogel tu allan ar fuarth neu gae yr ysgol(tymor yr haf). Ni ddylai'r un plentyn wisgo esgidiau gyda sodlau uchel(high heels)

5. Gwalltiau ac addurniadau

Nid yw lliwio gwallt yn rhan o'r wisg ysgol. Nid sioe ffasiynau yw'r ysgol chwaith. Gofynnir i rieni a gofalwyr wneud pob ymdrech i barchu'r rheol hon. Dim ond 'studs' sydd yn cael eu caniatau o ran clustlysau. Ni ddylid gwisgo unrhyw glustlysau ar gyfer gwersi addysg gorfforol. Trafodir unrhyw steil gwallt anarferol gyda rhieni pan fo'n berthnasol i wneud hyn.

Fel ysgol, mae gennym yr hawl i benderfynu beth sydd yn dderbyniol, ac sydd ddim yn dderbyniol i'w wisgo i ddod i'r ysgol.

Os oes rhesymau crefyddol yn gofyn i blentyn wisgo mewn modd arbennig, yna trafodir hyn gyda'r rhieni mewn dull sensitif a synhwyrol.

1. Introduction

It is school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school or when participating in a school organised event outside normal school hours.

The policy for school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school;
- engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- is practical and smart;
- makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance;
- is regarded as suitable wear for school and is considered by parents/carers as good value for money.

The school uniform policy is an integral part of the school's commitment to equality and inclusion. The governing body believes the school uniform policy allows all pupils to establish a shared identity and celebrate what they have in common, whilst respecting diversity. We wish to see the learners with the school logo on their jumper but this is not compulsory.

The school will also *ensure* opportunities for parents to buy second-hand school clothes (which have the school logo on them) on an */ongoing* basis and during Parents Evening / Events like Christmas Fair, Race the Train, Barbeque

If in doubt, please check with the school office before purchasing items for wear in school.

2. The School Uniform

We encourage parents / carers to purchase a school uniform from nursery age onwards. The uniform includes the following:

- trousers / skirt grey or black
- suitable black shoes
- white polo shirt
- green / maroon sweatshirt

During the summer term, pupils may choose to wear a ***** summer skirt/dress or shorts and suitable sandals if they wish.

3. Naming of uniform and lost property

Please make sure that all your child's clothes are clearly marked with the child's name. Shoes and plimsolls should also have names written inside. The school will endeavour to reunite lost named items with their owners. Unnamed lost property will be disposed of at the end of term or recycled.

4. Footwear

We encourage the children to wear black shoes for school. We believe that this contributes positively towards their appearance while attending school. School shoes must be shoes: no trainers. Shoes must be safe and sensible for playground and indoor use. No narrow or raised heels are allowed.

5. Hair and jewellery

The colouring of hair is not a part of the school's uniform. The school is not a fashion show either. We ask parents to make every effort to respect this rule. Only 'studs' are allowed in terms of earrings. These should be removed for physical education lessons and activities. When required, unusual hairstyles will be discussed with parents.

As a school, we have the right to decide on what is and what is not acceptable to wear in school. If for religious reasons, children are required to wear any special items of clothing, then this will be discussed with parents / carers in a sensitive and sensible way.
